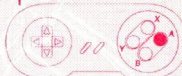

Raphael jumps into the air and sprays his opponent with fiery energy balls of destruction.



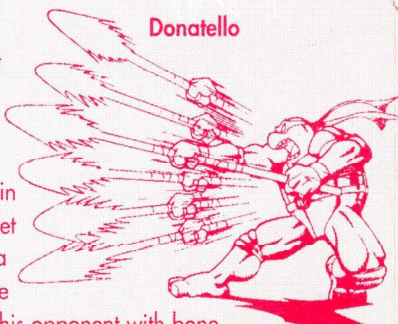
When Raphael's attack gauge is fully charged press the X & A buttons together. (Hint: Back Raphael up so that he doesn't overshoot his opponent.)

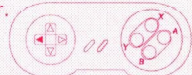
The Tons o' Turtle Drop

Just as Donatello is about to land on his unsuspectin' prey, press the down button, then the Y button.



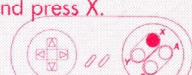
The Back-up Back Flip

Leonardo

Leonardo is always ready to fight. His moves are quick and deadly, yet easy to perform.

When you are using Leonardo to fight, remember, use your head.

Leonardo is best at strategy and advanced planning, so don't just blindly whack away. You need to have a plan. The following moves work differently on different opponents. It's up to you to find which move is best against which opponent.



The party is over — for anyone who takes on

Michaelangelo, that is.

This party-hearty hard shelled hero takes on all comers with more speed than any other Turtle. Michaelangelo uses his speed with great effectiveness in lightning attacks and speedy recovery. But when it comes time to finish off his opponent, it's time to use the moves below. Each one of these moves works great, but you'll have to figure out which move against which opponent works best.

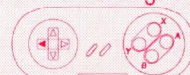
The Skull Crushin' Belly Flop

While Michaelangelo is in mid-jump over the other fighter, press the down button, then the Y button.



The Head Over Shell Back Flip

Press the back button twice and that'll send Michaelangelo flippin'.



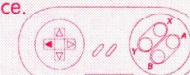
The Bashin' Body Blow

While Leonardo is high in the air above his opponent, press the down button, then the Y button.



The Back Bendin' Back Flip

To impress your friends and avoid a nasty blow to Leonardo's head, simply press back twice.



Over-the-back Bad Boy Bounce

Advance toward Leonardo's opponent and press X.



The Whippin' Whirl Throw

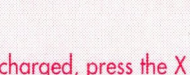
As you move Leonardo towards his opponent, press A.



Leonardo's Ultimate-Attack Move:

The MILLENNIUM WAVE

Leonardo thrusts out his arms and sends out a barrage of shock waves.

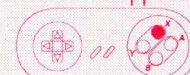


When Leonardo's attack gauge is fully charged, press the X & A buttons together. (Hint: Back Leonardo up so that he doesn't shoot his shatterin' shock waves past the other fighter.)



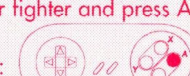
The Turtle Trash Toss

To toss the trash, move Michaelangelo towards his opponent and press X.



Super Sonic Spin Cycle

Move Michaelangelo towards the other fighter and press A.

Michaelangelo just goes nuts and starts to kick and punch with no end in sight.



When Michaelangelo's attack gauge is fully charged, press the X & A buttons together. (Hint: Back Michaelangelo up so that he can get a good run at his opponent.)

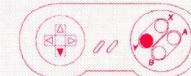

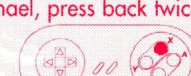
The Half Pike Body Press

When Raphael has jumped and he's just above his opponent, quickly press the down button, then the Y button.



The Dual Rotational Retreat

When things are gettin' hairy for Raphael, press back twice.



The Blind Back Toss

When you want Raphael to send his opponent flyin', and you don't care where he lands, then have Raphael move towards the other fighter and press X.
